NOTE: Exhibitors of Open Show Swine must be 7 years of age on or before January 1 of current year (2017). No one under the age of 7 is permitted to enter animals, or enter the show arena. The State Fair of West Virginia reserves the right to ask for proof of age by viewing their birth certificate.

FEES: For stalls - \$6.00 per head will be charged for each animal. To be paid when entries are made.

RULES:

1. All out of state purebred swine MUST have the recommended statement below on their Health Certificates:
"To the best of my knowledge, swine represented on this certificate have not originated from a premises known to be affected by Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea virus (PEDv), and have not been exposed to PEDv within the last 30 days."
2. All animals entered in the Swine Classes must be registered in the recognized American Herd books for their respective breeds. **Please attach a copy of registration papers with entry forms.**
3. All entries must give name and registry number, name and number of sire and dam, and date of birth as it appears on certificate of registry.
4. **PLEASE REFER TO ANIMAL HEALTH REGULATIONS.**
5. **No exhibitor shall be permitted to win more than two (2) premiums in a single class.**
6. **Exhibitors in the open swine show must be 7 years of age on or before January 1 of current year (2017) to exhibit. No one under the age of 7 is permitted to enter animals or enter the show arena. The State Fair of West Virginia reserves the right to ask for proof of age by viewing birth certificate.**
7. **NEW!! All Junior Show Exhibitors who show in the Jr. Purebred Swine division Must show in the Open Show. Junior Show Champions must go back to compete in the Open Show Champion classes.**
