

Protests at the State Fair of West Virginia

The State Fair of West Virginia is a 501©3 Non-profit on private property. Peaceful protests and demonstrations are allowed at the State Fair of West Virginia if the appropriate channels have been followed.

1. All protests and demonstrations MUST have at least one week advanced approval. All requests need to be submitted in writing to Kelly Collins, kellyt@statefairfw.com.
2. Protests and demonstrations MUST stay within designated areas.
3. No alcohol use is permitted.
4. No obscene posters or materials are allowed.
5. No handing out leaflets, trinkets, and the like other than from a licensed booth
6. Selling literature, trinkets, and the like other than from a licensed booth
7. Soliciting donations or contributions other than from a licensed booth
8. Soliciting signatures for a petition other than from a licensed booth
9. Uttering or displaying "fighting words" likely to provoke retaliation
10. Uttering or displaying words or gestures that incite imminent lawless action
11. Creating congregating or loitering which could interfere with the orderly, safe and efficient movement of the crowd or impede the flow of vehicular traffic.
12. No obscene language.
13. No weapons of any sort.
14. The State Fair of West Virginia's primary audience consists of family and youth and we reserve the right to reject any exhibit and/or contents that may be considered objectionable by that audience.
15. Anyone not in compliance with any of the above laws may be asked to leave the property.
