HEALTH REGULATIONS

ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS MUST HAVE A CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS WITHIN 12 MONTHS. IN ADDITION, ALL OUT OF STATE HORSES MUST HAVE A HEALTH CERTIFICATE (WITHIN 30 DAYS). THE HEALTH PAPERS WILL BE INSPECTED BY THE STATE VETERINARIAN. COPIES OF THE COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATES MUST BE ON FILE AT THE SHOW OFFICE, NO EXCEPTIONS.

PET POLICY

Seeing eye dogs and/or service dogs needed by the disabled will be permitted. Pets are allowed in offgrounds parking/camping areas, but they must be either on a leash or confined at all times. Dogs are NOT allowed around the show ring area while the show is in session. If dogs are found loose or not contained, you may be asked by the management, to leave the grounds and forfeit all entry, stall, and parking fees.

HORSES HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY AT ALL TIMES. DO NOT PARK GOLF CARTS OR OTHER VEHICLES ON THE STRAIGHTAWAY TO THE SHOW RING. THE HORSES, ESPECIALLY THE DRIVING HORSES, HAVE A DIFFICULT TIME TRYING TO GET TO THE RING. VIOLATORS MAY BE REQUIRED TO DISCONTINUE USING THEIR CARTS.

Entries do NOT need to qualify for STAKES or any class unless designated in the rule book.

All accounts MUST be paid in full and a GATE RELEASE must be obtained at the show office before leaving the fairgrounds. The gate release is to be given to the security at the exit gate.

All files must have a signed open check, made payable to, State Fair of WV or a credit card number on file in the show office, unless prior arrangements have been made with management.

Fireworks are Saturday, August 13 and Saturday, August 20, 2022 at 10:30 p.m.. ALL vehicles MUST be removed from the infield immediately after the Horse Show.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR IS ALLOWED IN ALL CLASSES.

- 1. Entries Entries must be postmarked by July 6, 2022. Any entry received after this date will be considered a post entry and be subject to post fees. Any entry received without payment will be considered a post entry. Stall reservations will not be honored without payment in full for entries. Entry blanks MUST be signed by an adult. Parent, guardian, agent, or trainer must sign for minors.
- Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current of the US Equestrian Federation Incorporation, Kentucky HIO, AWRHA, NCWHA, KWHA, EKWRHA, ETWHA, CKRHA, and VAWRHOA rules will be conducted and judge in accordance therewith. However, the Horse Show Manager's decision is final and is not protestable. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to submit entries that do not constitute a violation of these provisions. Ponies may not cross enter into horse classes or vice versa.
- 2. LATE ENTRY PENALTY RULES: ENTRIES CLOSED JULY **6**, **2022.** All entries postmarked later than this date will be accepted at the regular fee plus \$10.00 per horse post entry penalty. The date is according to the U.S. Postal post-mark, not a metered postmark. To receive credit for totally scratched horses, you must present a veterinarian certificate on official **letterhead.** This certificate must be received prior to the end of the horse show. All monies. **EXCEPT STALL FEES**, will be refunded if the horse show office is notified before August 10, 2022 for the first session; August 17, 2022, for the second session. For any cancelled horses, parking passes and gate admission tickets MUST be returned. Late penalty will not be charged for added classes for horses already entered in the show up to one half hour before the scheduled start of each session.

Classes scratched within one hour of the start of session will not be refunded. All scratches must be made AT LEAST ONE HOUR before the start of session.

3. **TRANSFER OF ENTRY FEES**: Exhibitor may transfer entry fees from one class to another when completed with show secretary one half (1/2) hour prior to session involved. Show Management will permit an exhibitor to enter another horse; however, the new entry must be given another number. Legal proof of sale, designating the name and address of the purchaser

will be required. Post Penalty Fees on a substitute horse will be waived provided entries are made within the established time limits. Stall fees will not be refunded. **Refunds will NOT be paid during the show**. Refunds/premium money will be mailed within forty-five (45) days after the close of the State Fair of West Virginia.

4. STALLS: ENTRIES WISHING TO BE STALLED TO-**GETHER SHOULD BE MAILED IN THE SAME ENVE-**LOPE. TACK STALLS ARE NOT GUARANTEED.TACK STALLS ARE BASED ON AVAILABILITY. We will make every attempt to fulfill stall requests. However, stall assignments are based on the number of stalls and availability. Specific stall requests cannot always be fulfilled. Exhibitors are encouraged to only reserve stalls for their animals showing in the current session. Should stall availability become a problem, those entries with animals not entered in that session may be required to move the animals to a different location or not be allowed in a stall until their showing session. ALL FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES TO BE AS-SURED OF STABLING. The Fair will charge \$100.00 if stall doors (tops or bottoms) have been removed or altered and are not put back in their original condition. All horses with stalls must show or will be assessed a fee of \$80.00 in addition to the price of the stall. Stalls are covered box stalls with two section doors in most.

Shavings can be purchased when entries are made (PRE-ORDER ONLY—\$ 8.00 PER BAG).

ALL HORSES MUST VACATE BY MONDAY MORNING, 12:00 NOON. FOR THE FIRST SESSION TO ALLOW CLEANING OF STALLS. THOSE WHO DO NOT LEAVE, WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$55.00 FOR EACH STALL.

- **ALL HORSES must be removed from the premises by 9:00 a.m. Sunday, 8/21/22, unless prior arrangements with office management have been made.
- 5. **PREMIUMS:** Classes with less than three (3) entries will be paid 2nd place & 3rd place premium money. **PREMIUMS WILL BE PAID BY CHECK TO THE PERSON DESIGNATED ON THE ENTRY BLANK AS AGENT.**Attempts will not be made by Show Management to obtain addresses which are not complete, legible, or correct on the entry blank. Premiums may not be mailed if agent fails to provide proper social security

number.

each Horse Owner (And Trainer if different from Owner). Parking permits are \$20.00 each and will be limited to the three days of each session and are valid for the period indicated thereon. These permits are nonreturnable and non-refundable. Such permit must be firmly affixed to the rear view mirror. Vehicles that do not have a permit affixed to the rear view mirror will be towed at the owner's expense. The fair will not attempt to locate the owner before towing. SHIP-INS MAY NOT ORDER PARKING PASSES as there is limited space in the infield. A parking pass is for the vehicle only. It does not gain admittance for the driver nor for the passengers. You must purchase extra gate passes when needed at the gate or ticket office. Parking will also be limited to the amount of parking spaces available at each area. (Refer to map on inside back cover for designated area near your stable.) Neither horse trailers, vans nor campers will be allowed to park in the areas designated as car parking areas. Tents are not allowed in parking areas. When passes are exhausted, no more will be issued. FREE auxiliary parking will be available in the general fair parking lot. Vehicles without valid parking permits or left in an area not designated as Horse Show Parking area will be towed away at owner's expense. Exhibitors with horses enter through Gate 5 - Livestock Gate on Route 219 North.

6. PARKING PERMITS: ONE (1) Parking Permit for cars

or trucks may be purchased when making entries for

7. CAMPERS: Forty (40) camper spaces will be available on a first come, first served basis at a cost of \$35.00 per day (NON REFUNDABLE). Must be in registered in exhibitors name. Campers will not be allowed to park in any area other than that designated as camping area. Camping is not allowed around Barn 12. NO EXCEPTIONS. The grounds surrounding the camper spaces are not to be used as a toilet area under any circumstances. The fair has sufficient and clean restrooms for all to use. Each camper parked on the grounds must display a fair permit.

Campers entering the fairgrounds must have a permit in their possession and MUST VACATE the grounds by NOON on Monday. DUE TO SPACE LIMITATION, AWNINGS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.

All **TENTS** must pay a camping fee and are only allowed in the camping area. **Horse trailers with living quarters must also pay a camping fee.**

CAMPING AND FREE PARKING are located across the street from the Fairgrounds. Call (304) 645-1090 for more information on camping & free parking.

- 8. **NOVICE HORSE OR NOVICE RIDER** may not have won three blue ribbons in the division they are showing in at the State Fair of West Virginia. Wins in driving do not affect status in under saddle and vice versa. Wins are only counted for State Fair of West Virginia, not other shows.
- 9. **RESERVATIONS:** Management reserves the right to:
 - a.) add to or vary the list of invited officials.
 - b.) cancel or combine any class with fewer than three (3) entries.
 - c.) refuse and return any or all entries without explanation or recourse to the State Fair of West Virginia.
 - d.) bar from the ring any rider, driver or attendant not properly attired or if it is in the best interest to the Horse Show.
 - e.) bar from the grounds any exhibitor or his employees who refuse to follow any of the rules of this Horse Show or the rules the State Fair of West Virginia.
- 10. SHIP-IN PARKING & PASSES: ALL ENTRIES **INCLUDING SHIP-INS MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED.** NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS WITHOUT A STABLE OR SHIP-IN PASS. A one-day ship-in parking pass (\$20.00 per horse/per day) will be issued to entries not obtaining stalls. This pass will be good only on the day the horse is showing. Ship-ins must be vacated within 1/2 (one-half) hour following the completion of their last class. On the nights of FIREWORKS, ship-in vehicles must vacate the infield IMMEDIATELY following the show. Shipins will not be allowed to stay overnight on the fairgrounds. Only 2 (two) gate passes per horse per day will be allowed with each horse shipped-in. All others must pay admission at the gate or purchased tickets at the ticket office.
- 11. **CONDUCT:** Any exhibitor, his agent or employee acting in a manner deemed improper or unsportsmanlike or using language deemed unfit or improper will be eliminated from further competition, removed from the fairgrounds and will forfeit all fees paid and premiums won. Upon the discovery of an aberrant act or unseemly behavior (including the consumption of alcoholic spirits) on the part of any exhibitor, owner, trainer, groomer or agent in the

barn and in public view, the Board of Directors, if such act is proven to their satisfaction, reserves the right to withhold the payment of any prizes awarded, to prohibit any such party or parties from exhibiting for one or more years, to publish the names of any such person or persons as may be deemed expedient, and to award a prize or prizes so withheld as though such exhibitor or exhibitors had not exhibited.

12. **HEALTH REGULATIONS:** It is required by management that each horse possess a current Negative Coggins Test. A copy must be attached to the entry blank.

WEST VIRGINIA -

- 1. Must be uniquely identifiable and
- Negative Coggins Test within the last 12 months.

OTHER STATES -

- Accompanied by a current (within 30 days) health certificate from the state of origin prior to show or fair and
- 2. Negative Coggins Test within the last 12 months. These will be inspected by the State Veterinarian. It is recommended by the State Veterinarian that all horses have the following vaccines prior to the horse show:
- 1.) Tetanus Toxoid, 2.) Eastern/Western Equine Encephalitis, 3.) West Nile Virus, 4.) Influenza, and 5.) Rabies.

NOTE: Animals from any herd or herds under restrictions will not be permitted to show. Animal Health Officials of the West Virginia Department of Agriculture reserve the right to examine any animal consigned, and exclude animals from the show that exhibit signs of disease.

13. OFF-ROAD VEHICLES:

Golf carts and scooters will be allowed in the horse show and stable area. There will be strict rules regarding these vehicles. They may only be driven by a licensed driver, and a fair issued permit must be displayed at all time.

Golf carts are ONLY allowed in the horse show and horse show stable area. The show office will give you a map showing designated areas. Anyone not following these rules will be subject to expulsion from the show grounds and will relinquish all claims for reimbursement of fees paid and will be issued a fine. ATV's, bicycles, skateboards, etc. are not allowed on either the main fairgrounds, the public parking/camping areas, or the horse show grounds.

State Fair management reserves the privilege of

having its own personnel use a limited number of service type vehicles.

- 14. **LUNGING:** Lunging of horses will not be allowed in the show arena. Lunging shall be limited to the practice ring.
- 15. **VETERINARIAN:** Name and phone number of veterinarian on duty can be obtained at the Horse Show Office.
- 16. GATE RULE: The PA system is provided as a courtesy to exhibitors; however, should the system be malfunctioning, it is the exhibitors' responsibility to have their entries ready for showing at least 10 minutes before the scheduled time for showing. When it is found that a class is being delayed by horses not ready to perform, the competition may be closed at the order of show management. Exhibitors are given two (2) minutes in which to appear at the in-gate ready to participate from the time the class is called. In classes in which horses compete collectively, after warning is issued, the in-gate must be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring. Judging will not commence until the gate is closed or at the end of the two minute call.

Horse is to be tacked as if giving a lesson. Snaffle and Martingale is encouraged on young riders, full bridles are acceptable. Any leverage bit rein is PROHIBITED through the martingale. The saddle must be consistent with the style of riding.

Horses must be neatly presented with clean coat and clipped bridle path, face, ears, and legs. Hoof blackening is acceptable and encouraged. Prohibited tack includes: Over checks, blinkers, or curb-bit or leverage reins through martingales in under-saddle classes.

NO SHOW PACKAGES! SHOE NOT TO EXCEED 18 oz. WITH ONE PAD AND/OR WEDGE FOR COMFORT OF THE HORSE. FARRIER WILL MAKE THE FINAL DECISION. These horses may NOT cross enter into other divisions at the show with a rider that is not in this division.

Country Pleasure Walking and All Day Pleasure Walking horses do not have to registered Walking. All other horses showing in specific Walking classes must be registered with TWHBEA.

Go As You Please Classes-Open to any non-padded horse regardless of what other division it may have shown in. Walk/favorite gait. Judged on best overall presentation, rider-to-mount suitability, and correctness while in the ring. Spooking, failure to follow the rail, and other mistakes should be penalized since this is a mixed breed class. Front end action, or other specific qualities associated with a particular discipline should be neither rewarded nor penalized in this class.

Easy Gait Classes- Entries in these entry level classes do not have to be registered, but must be gaited horses wearing a 3/8 x 3/4 or smaller shoe. These horses should be ridden on a loose rein and should appear to be a pleasure to ride. The gaits are to be a true

walk, and a smooth, easy pleasure gait. Judged on rider to mount suitability, ability of horse to work comfortably on a loose rein, neatness of appearance and overall presentation, and behavior of the horse in the ring. Mistakes should be penalized in judging and horses in this class should never display a labored, crampy, or gimmicky gait. A smooth, comfortable, easy gait shall be the paramount requirement for horses tied favorably.

These rules supersede the rules of any HIO or other association rules at this show.

Notably, under the KY-HIO, youth exhibitors may show a stallion in any class that is not a youth class. In addition, under the KY-HIO, a youth exhibitor may show a pony stallion in a youth class that allows Ponies.

Ship-ins will not be allowed to stay overnight on the fairgrounds. Ship-ins must vacate within one (1) hour following the completion of their last class. Only two persons will be allowed entrance to the fairgrounds with each horse shipped-in. All others must pay admission. Miniature Horse Exhibitors who need passes may purchase a ship-in pass and will be subject to ship-in rules. Miniature donkeys and mules are eligible for miniature horse classes.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All Draft Horse entries should be made on the special Draft Horse entry form, do not use the General Livestock or Open Horse Show entry forms.
- Horses will be exercised at a time and in a place to be specified by the State Fair; wagons and other equipment will be parked at a place designated by State Fair Officials.
- 4. Please refer to health regulations.
- 5. All colts MUST be broken to lead and MUST be shown under halter.
- 6. All livestock must be exhibited by owner as entered on entry blank. No substitutions.
- 7. Miniature Horses will be provided stalls, in the draft barn, only if space permits.
- 8. A small draft is defined as a horse of a draft breed in which the breed's standard height is 15.2 hands or under or draft horse crosses that are 15.2 hands and show characteristic draft breeding.
- 9. In hitch classes where more than two (2) horses are shown, they may be owned by one (1) or more exhibitors, but must be entered under one (1) name.
- 10. All entries should be ready well in advance of the class to avoid delays. If you see more time will be needed, please notify the ring steward so consideration may be addressed. The maximum time limit shall be five (5) minutes after the class is called by the ring steward.
- 11. Registration papers may be checked for all horses shown under halter, including geldings, for the registered Percheron, Clydesdales and Belgian shows, expect stallions and mares under one (1) year of age. Stallions and mares under one (1) year of age must be eligible to register with the Belgian Draft Horse Corporation of America, Percheron Horse Association of America, or The Clydesdale Breeders of the USA, and must carry the name of the animal, date of foaling and name of sire and dam.
 - *Please furnish a copy of registration papers

- for Registered Percheron, Clydesdales, and Belgian horses.
- 12. Mares and geldings of any draft breed, registered or non-registered, are eligible for all hitch classes unless limited by the class description.
- 13. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first serve basis if stalling horses. Every attempt will be made to accommodate all requests, but space is limited.
- 14. Management reserves the right to re-divide or combine classes based on the number of participants in each class.
- 15. Teams may not be shown in both the Best Hitch and Best Farm Team classes.
- 16. The SFWV Officials shall reserve the right to reject or refuse and to order the removal of any exhibit which, in the opinion of its board of directors/officials, is not eligible or worthy of showing or has not met the health requirements.
- 17. For junior division classes, the exhibitor shall be no younger than seven (7) years of age and no older than 17 years of age. All juniors must be accompanied by an adult.
- 18. West Virginia Equine Liability Act (Article 20-4-4) states the following: It is recognized that equestrian activities are hazardous to participants, regardless of feasible safety measures which can be taken. Each participant in an equestrian activity expressly assumes the risk of legal responsibility for any injury loss or damage to person or property which results from participation in an equestrian activity, on our around a horse.



A solid bottomed sled will be used for pulling. The first weight to be pulled will be a minimum of 3,000 pounds (including the sled). The judge will have the discretion to start at a higher weight. The weight must be pulled a distance of 27 1/2 feet in one pull to qualify and to continue. The width will be increased for the second pull and for each succeeding pull according to the judge's decision.

Each team will be allowed three (3) trials at each weight setting. A trial will constitute the moving of the sled and weight in any direction.

Fussing with the team or milling after it is hitched will NOT be tolerated. If any team becomes unmanageable or difficult to handle, and in the opinion of the judge becomes dangerous to the public, they will be disqualified and ordered to be taken from the field.

Pulling the team back against the sled and jumping or lunging them into a start will not be tolerated. Tugs and hitch must be reasonably tight when starting. Violators will be disqualified.

The load must be pulled in a straight direction; not seesawed from side to side. A roadway of 20 feet will be designated, and the team must not step outside at any time.

A driver cannot abuse or frighten his team in any way, either during a pull or between pulls.

Special effort will be made to keep the crowd quiet during each pull. If another teamster or handler interferes with the team making a pull, the person who interfered will be removed and his team disqualified.

Draft Horse Pull Rules and Regulations

Entry Fee \$ 20.00 per team (Non-refundable) Teams which are entered in the Draft Horse Competition may also be entered in the pulling contest by paying the entry fee. All horses must be checked-in by the superintendent by 8:00 a.m. on Friday, August 19, 2022.

Teams traveling and entered only in the pulling MAY request stalls at \$20.00 each (this does NOT include shavings), if stalls are available. If stalls are not available, teams will be allowed on to the grounds Friday morning, August 19, in time for the contest.

- All teams will be expected to leave the grounds immediately following the contest and awards.
- 2. ADMISSION POLICY: Each pulling team entry will receive four (4) single day gate passes prior to the fair.
- 3. Teams will be divided into Light Weight and Heavy Weight classes.
- 4. A stone boat or sled will be used.
- Refer to Draft Horse Pulling Rules for specific rules under which the contest will be conducted.
- 6. Teams must make a qualifying pull to be eligible for prize money.
- 7. Coggins and/or Health certificates must be on file in the Horse Show Office (please bring a copy with you for the office files)
- 8. Official weigh in will be 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. on the morning of the pull.
- 9. Draft team pair must be present at weigh in.
- 10. Handler MUST attend mandatory meeting in front of grandstand stage at 8:30 a.m. on the morning of the pull.
- 11. Monetary Awards will be mailed to the owner (specified on the entry form) within forty-five (45) days after the close of the State Fair of WV.

The Marvin D. Tuckwiller Memorial Trophy will be presented to the first place winner. The West Virginia Department of Agriculture will present trophies to the first, second, and third place teams.

Draft Horse Pulling Rules

- 1. Pulling Distance—27 1/2 feet
- 2. Width of Pulling Area—20 feet
- 3. Two Classes of Horses -
 - Light Weight— 3,400 pounds & under Heavy Weight—3,401 pounds & over
- 4. Hookers—Two (2) hookers, plus a driver to drive the teams will be allowed. All helpers must stay behind eveners and remain silent once the team is hooked. The driver must drive the team from behind the eveners. Only the driver may call on the team.
- 5. Boundaries—If a team steps on or over the side line, the pull attempt will not be counted.
- Three Pulls—Each driver is entitled to take 3 pulls. All teams must take the 1st pull. If he unhooks after the 1st pull, he forfeits his 2nd. He may come back, in order, for his 3rd attempt.
- Time Limit—Each team will have 3 minutes to hook after being called for the first pull. 1 minute between the 1st and 2nd attempt. The time for the 3rd pull is the same as the 1st.
- 8. Pull Attempts—3 unsuccessful attempts to hook will count as 1 pull attempt. Driver will have 6 attempts to get hitched. If all 6 attempts are missed the team will be eliminated. All the teams must take the 1st and 2nd pull to be entitled to a 3rd.
- Direction of Pull—1st and 2nd pulls shall be taken in the direction indicated by the judge. The 3rd pull may be taken in either direction, providing the sled is not past the end marker.
- 10. Movement of Sled—Any forward movement of the sled after the driver gives command to go will be counted as a pull and measurement will be recorded, except with breakage of equipment. If sled is advanced over 18 inches between 2nd and 3rd attempts, the distance will be counted at 18 inches for 3rd attempt.
- 11. Breakage of Equipment—The team must remain in the pulling area and come in at the end of the round for their turn and pick up their proper place the next round. The team has 5 minutes to make repairs.

- 12. Drivers—Each team shall be driven by one driver at all times through the entire contest, except in the case of driver injury.
- 13. Heading of Horses—The heading of horses is prohibited. In case of unhooked tug, or horse over tug, the driver must unhitch from the sled, then correct the problem and then hitch again for the same pull.
- 14. Treatment of Horses— Drivers shall not prod, whip or touch the horses while pulling and in no case whirl or shake the lines over horses or above his own head. Jumping of doubletree is not allowed. First penalty—loss of one pull attempt; Second penalty—disqualification from the entire pull.
- 15. Unmanageable Teams—If any team becomes unmanageable or difficult to handle, and in the opinion of the judges may endanger other teams, drivers, or spectators, they will be frozen in position and ordered taken from the field. If any team breaks away from the driver or helpers or runs away, it forfeits any premium it might have earned in the contest up to the time it runs away.
- 16. Conduct of Horsemen—Behavior of all horsemen (driver and helpers) will be above reproach at all times. Disciplinary action by the judges will be taken. Anyone disrupting the decision of the judges will be immediately disqualified. This includes all teams the driver has in the contest.
- 17. Bridles and Other Equipment—Bridles may be open-faced or with blinders. No change can be made after the contest starts. Teams may be tied together with check lines only. Hitching with cross tugs in prohibited. No bits, chains, or extras will be hung on the harness.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR HORSES

All out-of-state horses must be accompanied by an official CVI good for 30 days.

From West Virginia:

- (1) Must be uniquely identified, and
- (2) Have a negative Coggins' Test (from a USDA official approved laboratory) within the last 12 months.

From Other States:

(1) Must be uniquely identified.

- (2) Accompanied by an approved CVI from the state of origin prior to show or fair, and
- (3) A negative Coggins' Test (from a USDA official approved laboratory) within the last 12 months.

RECOMMENDED EQUINE VACCINATIONS

See page 27 Rule # 12

PARKING PASS to park on grounds in the horse show area will need to be purchased. (The parking pass will be \$20.00 for Thursday and Friday that Youth Horse and Pony Exhibitors will be showing)

If you miss the July 6, 2022 registration deadline fee of \$10 per horse will be added to your registration. You may register until 1 hour prior to the beginning of the session.

If changes need to be made to your entries, please see the horse show office staff upon arrival to the fairgrounds to make any necessary changes (class additions / scratches / change of exhibitor)

CAMPING – All Horse Show exhibitor camping requests will be handled by the State Fair Horse Show Office at http://www.statefairofwv.com/equine/

Attention! Youth Show horses will be stalled in the racing barns, Open Show will be in the other horse barns. If you plan on staying for the open show and <u>do not want</u> to have to be moved please indicate this on the Horse Show Entry Blank.

Pattern classes: Patterns for all pattern classes will be posted before the start of classes. Exhibitors will be responsible for knowing their patterns prior to their class.

Alcohol is **NOT** permitted on State Fair property.

PET POLICY

Seeing eye dogs and/or service dogs needed by the disabled will be permitted. Pets are allowed in off-grounds parking/camping areas, but they must be either on a leash or confined at all times. Dogs are NOT allowed around the show ring area while the show is in session . If dogs are found loose or not contained, you may be asked by the management, to leave the grounds and forfeit all entry, stall, and parking fees.

Miscellaneous: In 1996 the State Fair of West Virginia adopted the IAFE (International Association of Fairs and Expositions) National Code of Show Ring Ethics and its accompanying "Exhibitor Entry Statement." This information is enclosed and the Exhibitors Entry Statement is included on the Official Entry Form. By signing the "Exhibitor Entry Statement," you and your parents and/or guardians have agreed to abide by the rules as stated in the IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics. All exhibitors must comply with both the General Rules and Regulations, if for any reason your animal is currently being treated by a veterinarian, a letter of verification listing prescribed treatment must be turned in to the Show Office upon arrival to the fairgrounds. The intent of this program is to reflect the highest standards of honor and dignity to the public and/or consumer in West Virginia and to promote the advancement of agricultural education.

Veterinary services are available by the State Fair and/or local veterinarians; however, exhibitors are responsible for payment of services.

Please direct any questions or suggestions you may have to us. Look forward to seeing you at the West Virginia State Fair!

Exhibitors will receive barn map and parking pass from the Fair Office concerning their entries before the fair.

STATE FAIR OF WEST VIRGINIA YOUTH HORSE AND PONY SHOW

A. Youth / Junior

Youth – Exhibitors must be at least 7 years of age during the current year, but less than 12 on or before January 1st of the current year.

Junior—Exhibitors must be at least 12 years of age during the current year, bus less than 18 on or before January 1st of the current year.

B. Hard Hat Policy – ALL youth participants in the State Fair of WV Youth Horse and Pony Show MUST wear protective headgear that meets or surpasses current applicable American Society of Testing Materials (ASTM) standards with Safety Engineering Institute (SEI) certification. The harness must be secured whenever mounted.

If a youth comes to the ring-gate without protective headgear, he/she will be refused entry to the class. Anyone caught riding outside the ring without a helmet may be disqualified from further participation in that particular show or event.

It is recognized, that in some instances, availability of appropriate safety headgear for saddle seat and other riding styles may be a problem. Judges will be instructed that suitability for safety headgear for a specific class is not to be a factor in placing that class.

- C. NO STALLIONS, regardless of age, will be permitted in any Youth Horse and Pony class. "Unless the breed or HIO rulebook which is applicable at this show allows for specific exceptions. Notably, under the KY-HIO, youth exhibitors may show a stallion in any class that is not a youth class. In addition, under the KY-HIO, a youth exhibitor may show a pony stallion in a youth class that allows ponies"
- D. Miniature horse will be under 38 inches tall.
- E. A **horse** will be 14.2 hands and over.
- F. A **pony** will be under 14.2 hands.
- G. Forbidden substances or methods are not permissible. Horses must be made available for drug testing upon the request of show management. Failure to do so is an admission of guilt and punishment.

- 1. Administration of any drug affecting the central nervous system (stimulant or depressant) to a horse shown in any class is strictly prohibited.
- 2. Full use of modern therapeutic measures for the health of the horse, including non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs, is permitted unless the drug given may also stimulate or depress the circulatory, respiratory, or nervous system. A veterinarian's certificate must be filed with show management prescribing the anti-inflammatory drug prior to showing.
- 3. The use of irritants (including blisters, ginger, or similar soring or pain-inducing substances or devices) that affect the gait, carriage, or performance of a horse is forbidden.
- 4. Any exhibitor guilty of showing an animal under the influence of any prohibited drug, using any forbidden substance or failing to file a veterinarian's certificate prior to showing will be disqualified and will forfeit all winnings from the show. Additional penalties may also be given by show management based on the situation.
- H. Cruelty or rough handling of horses will not be allowed at any show. The stewards, judge or show committee may disqualify anyone mistreating an animal.
- I. Any **discourtesy displayed** by an exhibitor, parent or trainer toward show officials, other exhibitors, or parents may result in forfeiture of ribbons and/or premiums. Flagrant violations or discourtesies may result in the banning of an exhibitor from future youth shows.
- J. A rider is considered to have fallen if separated from a horse that has not fallen (for example, if the rider needs to remount or vault back into the saddle) A horse is considered to have fallen when its shoulder and haunch on the same side have touched the ground or an obstacle on the ground.
- K. In any class, the judge shall have the authority to require the removal or alteration of any piece of equipment that, in his/her opinion, would tend to give a horse an unfair advantage or that he/she believes is inhumane.
- L. All **tack** must be clean, safe, serviceable condition and should fit the rider and the horse.

M. Closed-toe shoes are required at all times when working with a horse from the ground or when mounted. Show attire is discipline-specific; however, long-sleeved shirts, full-length pants and boots are generally expected.

Show Management

- A. The show management will be responsible for the operation of the show and enforcement of all rules.
- B. The show management or judge will determine the course/pattern for any class. The course/pattern will be posted at least one hour before the scheduled time of the class.
- C. The show management will eliminate any improper entry of a horse, rider, or driver.
- D. The show management will determine the working order in the individual performance classes.

Judge

- A. Good judging depends upon the correct observance of horses or riders and the measurement of them against horses or riders and the measurement of them against a standard commonly accepted as the ideal, according the condition of the class being judged.
- B. The judge will adjudicate each class in conformity with the rules and specifications of the class.
- C. The decision of each judge is final.
- D. An exhibitor does not have the right to inspect the judge's card. However, an exhibitor may request the reason for a decision from the show management or ring steward. The show management may request the judge to give his/her reasoning at a proper time and place. A judge is not to be approached with regard to any decision while judging or about to judge. E. No judge may be approached by an exhibitor, parent, or trainer without first obtaining the permission of the ring steward or show management.


