HEALTH REGULATIONS

ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS MUST HAVE A CUR-RENT NEGATIVE COGGINS WITHIN 12 MONTHS. IN ADDITION, ALL OUT OF STATE HORSES MUST HAVE A HEALTH CERTIFICATE (WITHIN 30 DAYS). THE HEALTH PAPERS WILL BE INSPECTED BY THE STATE VETERINAR-IAN. PAPER COPIES OF THE COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATES MUST BE ON FILE AT THE SHOW OFFICE, NO EXCEPTIONS.

PET POLICY

NO pets are allowed at ringside while the show is in session. Exhibitors' pets are allowed to accompany their owners at the horse show when the show is not in session and in the parking and camping areas, as long as they are on a leash or confined at all times. Pets are NOT permitted on the main fairgrounds, outside of the horse show's designated areas. If you are found not following the Pet Policy, you will be required to leave the grounds and forfeit all fees paid and premiums won.

HORSES HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY AT ALL TIMES. DO NOT PARK GOLF CARTS OR OTHER VEHICLES ON THE STRAIGHTAWAY TO THE SHOW RING. THE HORSES, ESPECIALLY THE DRIVING HORSES, HAVE A DIFFICULT TIME TRYING TO GET TO THE RING. VIOLATORS MAY BE REQUIRED TO DISCONTINUE USING THEIR CARTS.

Entry fees \$ 40.00 per class MONETARY AWARDS ONLY Payouts will be for 1st (75%) and 2nd (25%) place from total entry fee money collected and any applicable sponsorship money. At discretion of management, classes may be split, depending on number of entries.



The Horse Show has added **TO BE DETERMINED CLASSES** to the show. Become a sponsor, (\$150 Regular Class and \$275 STAKE Class) and you can name the class as well as provide a class description to select the gaits. Subject to Show Management approval.

Another event for this year is **DRY COW RANCH RIDING** (Class 331). This class allows the rider and horse to perform as a team to present their skills without cattle in the show pen. This class involves a working pattern filled with lead changes, stops, back-ups, spins in both directions, and a transition of gaits and speed.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM THE SHOW OFFICE

ONLY ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 11, the High School Rodeo will be utilizing the horse show warm-up ring. The upper ring will be unavailable for use by the Open Horse Show exhibitors who will use a designated area of the track for warming up their horses.

ENTRIES DO NOT NEED TO QUALIFY FOR STAKE CLASSES or any other class unless designated in the rule book.

THE OFFICE WILL CLOSE 1/2 HOUR BEFORE THE START OF EACH SESSION in order to prepare for the show. The office will reopen after the session begins.

NO CLASS ADDITIONS OR SCRATCHES WILL BE ACCEPTED BY PHONE/TEXTS/EMAIL DURING THE SHOW. Changes must be completed on paper and signed.

ALL ACCOUNTS MUST HAVE A SIGNED OPEN CHECK made payable to: State Fair of WV or a **CREDIT CARD NUMBER** on file in the show office, unless prior arrangements have been made with management.

ALL ACCOUNTS MUST BE PAID IN FULL AND A GATE RE-LEASE MUST BE OBTAINED at the show office before leaving the fairgrounds. The gate release is to be given to the security at the exit gate.

PAPER COPIES OF COGGINS AND HEALTH PAPERS (if out of state) MUST be submitted with entry or provided upon check-in at the show office.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR IS ALLOWED IN ALL CLASSES AND REQUIRED IN THE YOUTH SHOW

1. ENTRIES: Must be postmarked by July 5, 2023. Any entry received after this date will be considered a post entry and be subject to post fees. Any entry received without payment will be considered a post entry. Office fee is \$5 per horse entered. Stall reservations will not be honored without payment in full for entries. Entry blanks MUST be signed by an adult. Parent, guardian, agent, or trainer must sign for minors. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current of the US Equestrian Federation Incorporation, Kentucky HIO, AWRHA, NCWHA, KWHA, EKWRHA, ETWHA, CKRHA, VAWRHOA, and ASHA rules will be conducted and judge in accordance therewith. However, the Horse Show Manager's decision is final and is not protestable. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to submit entries that do not constitute a violation of these provisions. Ponies may not cross enter into horse classes or vice versa. A pony will be under 14.2 hands. A horse will be 14.2 hands and over. A miniature horse will be under 38 inches tall. For all pony only classes, a letter is required by the horse show office to verify the height of a pony by a farrier or veterinarian.

2. LATE ENTRY PENALTY RULES: ENTRIES CLOSE JULY

5, 2023. All entries postmarked later than this date will be accepted at the regular fee plus \$10.00 per horse post entry penalty. The date is according to the U.S. Postal post-mark, not a metered postmark. To receive credit for totally scratched horses, you must present a veterinarian certificate on official letterhead. This certificate must be received prior to the end of the horse show. All monies, EXCEPT STALL FEES, will be refunded if the horse show office is notified before August 9, 2023 for the first session; August 16, 2023, for the second session. For any cancelled horses, parking passes and gate admission tickets MUST be returned. Late penalty will not be charged for added classes for horses already entered in the show up to one half hour before the scheduled start of each session.

All scratches must be made AT LEAST ONE HOUR before the start of session or will not be refunded. 3. **TRANSFER OF ENTRY FEES**: Exhibitor may transfer entry fees from one class to another when completed with show secretary one half (1/2) hour prior to session involved. Show Management will permit an exhibitor to enter another horse; however, the new entry must be given another number. Legal proof of sale, designating the name and address of the purchaser will be required. Post Penalty Fees on a substitute horse will be waived provided entries are made within the established time limits. Stall fees will not be refunded. **Refunds will NOT be paid during the show**. Refunds/premium money will be mailed within fortyfive (45) days after the close of the State Fair of West Virginia.

4. STALLS: ENTRIES WISHING TO BE STALLED TOGETH-ER SHOULD BE MAILED IN THE SAME ENVELOPE. TACK STALLS ARE NOT GUARANTEED. TACK STALLS ARE BASED ON AVAILABILITY. We will make every attempt to fulfill stall requests. However, stall assignments are based on the number of stalls and availability. Specific stall requests cannot always be fulfilled. Exhibitors are encouraged to only reserve stalls for their animals showing in the current session. Should stall availability become a problem, those entries with animals not entered in that session may be required to move the animals to a different location or not be allowed in a stall until their showing session. ALL FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES TO BE ASSURED OF STA-BLING. The Fair will charge \$100.00 if stall doors (tops or bottoms) have been removed or altered and are not put back in their original condition. All horses with stalls must show or will be assessed a fee of \$80.00 in addition to the price of the stall. Stalls are covered box stalls with two section doors in most.

Shavings can be purchased when entries are made

(PRE-ORDER ONLY—\$ 10.00 PER BAG). ALL FIRST SESSION HORSES MUST VACATE ON MON-DAY BY NOON TO ALLOW FOR CLEANING OF STALLS. THOSE WHO DO NOT LEAVE, WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$55.00 FOR EACH STALL.

**ALL HORSES must be removed from the premises by 9:00 a.m. Sunday, 8/20/23, unless prior arrangements with office management have been made.

5. **PREMIUMS:** Classes with less than three (3) entries will be paid 2nd place & 3rd place premium money. **PREMIUMS WILL BE PAID BY CHECK TO THE PERSON DESIGNATED ON THE ENTRY BLANK AS AGENT.**

Attempts will not be made by Show Management to obtain addresses which are not complete, legible, or correct on the entry blank. Premiums may not be mailed if agent fails to provide proper social security number.

6. **PARKING PERMITS:** ONE (1) Parking Permit for cars or trucks may be purchased when making entries for each Horse Owner (And Trainer if different from Owner). Parking permits are \$20.00 each and will be limited to each session and are valid for the period indicated thereon. **These permits are non-returnable and non-refundable.** Such permit must be firmly affixed to the rear view mirror. Vehicles that do not have a permit affixed to the rear view mirror will be towed at the owner's expense. The fair will not attempt to locate the owner before towing.

SHIP-INS MAY NOT ORDER PARKING PASSES as there is limited space in the infield. A parking pass is for the vehicle only. It does not gain admittance for the driver nor for the passengers. You must purchase extra gate passes when needed at the gate or ticket office. Parking will also be limited to the amount of parking spaces available at each area. (Refer to map on inside back cover for designated area near your stable.) Neither horse trailers, vans nor campers will be allowed to park in the areas designated as car parking areas. Tents are not allowed in parking areas. When passes are exhausted, no more will be issued. FREE auxiliary parking will be available in the general fair parking lot. Vehicles without valid parking permits or left in an area not designated as Horse Show Parking area will be towed away at owner's expense. Exhibitors with horses enter through Gate 5 - Livestock Gate on Route 219 North.

7. CAMPERS: Forty (40) camper spaces will be available on a first come, first served basis at a cost of \$35.00 per day (NON REFUNDABLE). Must be registered in exhibitors name. Campers will not be allowed to park in any area other than that designated as camping area. Camping is not allowed around Barn 12 unless designated by management. The grounds surrounding the camper spaces are not to be used as a toilet area under any circumstances. The fair has sufficient and clean restrooms for all to use. Each camper parked on the grounds must display a fair permit. Campers entering the fairgrounds must have a permit in their possession and MUST VACATE the grounds by NOON on Monday, Aug. 21 . DUE TO SPACE LIMITATION, AWNINGS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.

All **TENTS** must pay a camping fee and are only allowed in the camping area. Horse trailers with living quarters must also pay a camping fee.

CAMPING AND FREE PARKING are located across the street from the Fairgrounds. Call (304) 645-1090 for more information on camping & free parking.

8. NOVICE HORSE OR NOVICE RIDER: May not have won three blue ribbons in the division they are showing in at the State Fair of West Virginia. Wins in Driving do not affect status in Under Saddle and vice versa. Wins are only counted for State Fair of West Virginia, not other shows.

9. RESERVATIONS: Management reserves the right to:

- a.) add to or vary the list of invited officials.
- b.) cancel or combine any class with fewer than three (3) entries.
- c.) refuse and return any or all entries without explanation or recourse to the State Fair of West Virginia.
- d.) bar from the ring any rider, driver or attendant not properly attired or not in the best interest to the Horse Show.
- e.) bar from the grounds any exhibitor or his employees who refuse to follow any of the rules of this Horse Show or the rules the State Fair of West Virginia.

10. SHIP-IN PARKING & PASSES: ALL ENTRIES INCLUDING SHIP-INS MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS WITHOUT A STABLE OR SHIP-IN PASS. A one-day ship-in parking pass (\$20.00 per horse/per day) will be issued to entries not obtaining stalls. This pass will be good only on the day the horse is showing. Ship-ins must be vacated within 1/2 (one-half) hour following the completion of their last class. On the nights of FIREWORKS, ship-in vehicles must vacate the infield IMMEDIATELY following the show. Shipins will not be allowed to stay overnight on the fair grounds. Only 2 (two) gate passes per horse per day will be allowed with each horse shipped-in. All others must pay admission at the gate or purchased tickets at the ticket office.

11. **CONDUCT:** The State Fair of West Virginia Horse Show requires that all exhibitors and attendees comply with the International Association of Fairs and Expositions (IAFE) Code of Show Ring Ethics. By entering the show, you agree to abide by the IAFE Code of Show Ring Ethics. All exhibitors and attendees must act in an appropriate manner, practice good sportsmanship and be a positive influence for others. If an exhibitor or attendee acts in an inappropriate manner or partakes in an illegal activity, the Show Management reserves the right to notify the proper authorities and remove the individual from the show. If an exhibitor is required to leave the fairgrounds, fees paid and premiums won will be forfeited.

12. **HEALTH REGULATIONS:** It is required by management that each horse possess a current Negative Coggins Test. A paper copy must be attached to the entry blank to remain in Show Office. **WEST VIRGINIA**

a.) Must be uniquely identifiable andb.) Negative Coggins Test within the last 12 months.

OTHER STATES

- a.) Accompanied by a current (within 30 days) a health certificate from the state of origin prior to show or fair **and**
- b.) Negative Coggins Test within the last 12 months.

These will be inspected by the State Veterinarian. It is recommended by the State Veterinarian that all horses have the following vaccines prior to the horse show:

1.) Tetanus Toxoid, 2.) Eastern/Western Equine Encephalitis, 3.) West Nile Virus, 4.) Influenza, and 5.) Rabies.

NOTE: Animals from any barn under restrictions will not be permitted to show. Animal Health Officials of the West Virginia Department of Agriculture reserve the right to examine any animal and exclude animal from the show that exhibit signs of disease.

13. OFF-ROAD VEHICLES:

Golf carts and scooters will be allowed in the horse show and stable area. There will be strict rules regarding these vehicles. They may only be driven by a licensed driver, and a fair issued permit must be displayed at all time. Golf carts are ONLY allowed in the horse show and horse show stable area. The show office will give you a map showing designated areas. Anyone not following these rules will be subject to expulsion from the show grounds and will relinquish all claims for reimbursement of fees paid and will be issued a fine. ATV's, bicycles, skateboards, etc. are not allowed on either the main fairgrounds, the public parking/camping areas, or the horse show grounds. State Fair management reserves the privilege of having its own personnel use a limited number of service type vehicles.

14. **LUNGING:** Lunging of horses will not be allowed in the show arena. Lunging shall be limited to the practice ring.

15. **VETERINARIAN:** Name and phone number of veterinarian on duty can be obtained at the Horse Show Office.

16. GATE RULE: The PA system is provided as a courtesy to exhibitors; however, should the system be malfunctioning, it is the exhibitors' responsibility to have their entries ready for showing at least 10 minutes before the scheduled time for showing. When it is found that a class is being delayed by horses not ready to perform, the competition may be closed at the order of show management. Exhibitors are given two (2) minutes in which to appear at the in-gate ready to participate from the time the class is called. In classes in which horses compete collectively, after warning is issued, the in-gate must be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring. Judging will not commence until the gate is closed or at the end of the two minute call.

18. HORSE SHOW NUMBERS: A number will be assigned to each horse at the time the entry is received, this number will stand for the entire State Fair Horse Show and must be displayed whenever the horse is in the ring.

19. **PRACTICE RING:** The practice ring will be available to warm up horses. All horses will cross the race track at the designated passage way.

20. PROHIBITION OF DRUGS AND CRUELTY TO

HORSES: The administering of any drug affecting the central nervous system to a horse shown in a class is strictly prohibited. Horses must be made available for drug testing upon the request of the show man-

agement. Penalties will be given by show management based on the situation. Cruelty or rough handling of horse will not be tolerated. The ring steward, Judge, or show management may disqualify anyone mistreating an animal. The exhibitor will be asked to leave the fairgrounds and forfeit all entry fees and premiums.

21. **SHOW ATTIRE:** Show attire is discipline specific; however, long sleeved shirts, full length pants and boots are generally expected. Closed toe shoes are required at all times when working with a horse from the ground or when mounted.

22. **SHOW MANAGEMENT**: Show management is responsible for the operation of the show, the enforcement of all rules, and has the right to address any safety issues or concerns in any class. Show management or the Judge will select the pattern for a patterned class and post the pattern **at least one hour before** the scheduled time of the class. The horse show office will determine the working order in the individual performance classes.

23. **JUDGE:** The judge will adjudicate each class in conformity with the rules and specifications of the class. The decision of each judge is final.

24. **NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS:** All non-negotiable checks will incur a \$30 return check fee.

25. **PRIOR TO DEPARTURE:** All accounts must be settled prior to departure. A gate release must be obtained from the show before leaving the fairgrounds. The gate release is to be given to the security at the exit gate.

26. ENTRY AGREEMENT: by entering this competition and signing the entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree to release and hold harmless the competition, their officials, directors, and employees for any action taken under their rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the State Fair of West Virginia and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likeness of me and/or my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition or the State Fair of WV. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

27. NEITHER THE STATE FAIR OF WEST VIRGINIA, NOR THE MANAGEMENT, NOR THE SHOW OFFICIALS ARE TO BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAM-AGE THAT MIGHT OCCUR, AND IT WILL BE THE CON-DITION OF THE ENTRY THAT EACH EXHIBITOR SHALL HOLD THE HORSE SHOW AND ITS MANAGEMENT BLAMELESS FOR ANY LOSS OR ACCIDENT TO ANY ANIMAL, PERSON OR PROPERTY THAT MAY OCCUR FROM SICKNESS, FIRE AND OTHERWISE AT THIS SHOW.

YOUTH HORSE AND PONY SHOW

Youth Exhibitors must be at least 7 years of age during the current year, but less than 12 on or before January 1st of the current year. Junior Exhibitors must be at least 12 years of age during the current year, but less than 18 on or before January 1st of the current year. ALL participants in this show MUST wear protective headgear or will be refused entry from the class. Also, anyone caught riding outside the ring without protective head gear may be disqualified from further participation in this show. NO STALLIONS will be permitted in any Youth Horse and Pony class, "Unless the breed or HIO rulebook which is applicable at this show allows for specific exemptions. Notably, under the KY-HIO, youth exhibitors may show a stallion in any class that is not a youth class. In addition, under the KY-HIO, a youth exhibitor may show a pony stallion in a youth class that allows ponies." A miniature horse will be under 38 inches tall. A horse will be 14.2 hands and over. A pony will be under 14.2 hands. FOR ALL PONY ONLY CLASSES, a letter is REQUIRED by the Horse Show office to verify the height of the pony by a Farrier or Veterinarian. The gaits for each class are stated in the class schedule. Patterns will be posted at the Show Office prior to the show. Riding exhibitors must have their feet in stirrups and hands holding reins in one hand and NOT holding on to the saddle with BOTH hands. Exhibitors must complete an entry form to register for a class. A paper copy of each animal's negative Coggins (within the last 12 months) is required and must be on file at the Show Office. All Out of State horses must have both a copy of the negative Coggins and a health certificate that is current within 30 days at the Show Office. (See Number 12 under Rules and Regulations). The Youth Show stalls must be cleaned and vacated by August 12 by Noon.





ACADEMY OPEN TO ANY BREED

Ribbon Award Classes Stallions are prohibited

The riders in this division are students who are currently taking riding lessons. The rider will be judged on basic equitation skills and the ability to control the horse. To ensure the safety of other riders, any **out of control horse** will be immediately excused. The class will be stopped by the judge until the horse and rider have been assisted out of the ring.

Riders may enter and show in Go As You Please classes, but MAY NOT enter in any other division at the show. A rider who has shown in a regular division class or in a full riding suit at any show is prohibited from participating further in the academy division.

What to Wear

Shirts—All riders should wear long sleeved, button down shirts with vest and a tie.
Pants—to consist of jodhpurs
Footwear—to consist of paddock or jodhpur boots
Headgear—Safety helmets are the only acceptable headgear.
Hair—must be neatly pulled back in a bun or braid
Gloves and Whips are optional. However, spurs are prohibited.
No barn logos or identifying marks of any kind on any student or horse.

Riding suits and derbies are NOT allowed.

Horse

Horses that are used are to be LESSON HORSES. Horse must be a Mare or Gelding and must have a full mane and tail. School horse may be owned or leased by a rider as long as it is a lesson horse, mare or gelding, and a full mane and tail.

Horse is to be tacked as if giving a lesson. Snaffle and Martingale is encouraged on young riders, full bridles are acceptable. Any leverage bit rein is PROHIBITED through the martingale. The saddle must be consistent with the style of riding.

Horses must be neatly presented with clean coat and clipped bridle path, face, ears, and legs. Hoof blackening is acceptable and encouraged. Prohibited tack includes: Over checks, blinkers, or curb-bit or leverage reins through martingales in under-saddle classes.

NO SHOW PACKAGES! SHOE NOT TO EXCEED 18 oz. WITH ONE PAD AND/OR WEDGE FOR COM-FORT OF THE HORSE. FARRIER WILL MAKE THE FINAL DECISION. These horses may NOT cross enter into other divisions at the show with a rider that is not in this division.

HOLDS—There will be minimum holds allowed, please be prepared to enter the ring when the class is called, there will be **a two minute gate call per class**. This division is open to all breeds of horses.

DRAFT HORSE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Draft Horse Division is open to All Breeds of Draft Horses both large and small.
 A Small Draft is defined as a horse of draft breed in which the breed's standard height is 15.2 hands or under or draft horse crosses that are 15.2 hands and show characteristic draft breeding. No Draft Mules are Allowed.
- 2. All Draft Horse entries are to be made on the special Draft Horse entry form, do not use the Open Horse Show entry form. Fees are to paid when entries are made. If you foresee several changes in classes (additions) during the show, a signed open check made payable to: State Fair of WV or a credit card number can be left on file at the horse show office. Entries will be accepted on a first-come basis if stalling horses. Every attempt will be made to accommodate all requests, but space is limited. Colts occupying stalls to them selves, will be charged full price. DO NOT **RESERVE EXTRA STALLS FOR TACK; request stalls** for the actual number of horses that you plan to exhibit. Draft Horse exhibitors will be issued TWO (2) gate admission passes per horse, per day. Copies of the Registration Papers are required for Registered Percherons, Clydesdales, and Belgian Horses except stallions and mares under one (1) year of age. Stallions and mares under (1) year of age must be eligible to register with their breed associations. All entries, including ship-ins, must be pre-registered. Miniature Horses will be provided stalls, in the draft barn, only if space permits.

- 3. All in-state horses must have a current negative Coggins within 12 months. In addition, all out of state horses must have a negative Coggins and a Health Certificate (with in 30 days of showing). The Coggins and Health Papers will be inspected by the State Veterinarian. Paper copies of the Coggins and Health Papers must be on file at the horse show office, no exceptions.
- 4. Ship-ins will only be allowed on Sunday, August 13, 2023 for the Registered Draft Classes. A oneday ship-in parking pass \$20.00 per vehicle. Exhibitors will receive two (2) passes to enter the gate. Any additional passes will have to be purchased at the gate. Miniature Horse exhibitors who need passes may purchase a ship-in pass and will be subject to the ship-in rules. Ship-ins must vacate within one hour following the completion of their class. If the exhibitor is traveling from long distances for this show, call the Horse Show Secretary to discuss stalling options. The Registered Draft Horses do have the option to participate in the Monday, August 14—4 p.m. classes.
- 5. All colts MUST be broken to lead and MUST be shown under halter.
- Horses will be exercised in a location specified by the Horse Show Management. The wagons and other equipment will be parked at a place designated by the Horse Show Management.
- 7. All entries and/or changes (name of drivers) in all Driving Classes must be made ½ hour prior to each session. Horse Show Management reserves the rights to split a class for safety purposes. In larger Driving Classes, the ring steward will direct the class as to lining up in the center or being asked to stop on the rail and then pulled from the rail when winning entries are announced.
- In Hitch classes where two (2) horses are shown, they may be owned by (1) or more exhibitors, but be entered under one name. Mares and geldings of any draft breed, registered or non-

registered, are eligible for all hitch classes unless limited by the class description.

- 9. At the start and duration of the show, all entries should be ready well in advance to avoid delays. If you need more time, please notify the horse show office, so consideration may be addressed. The maximum time limit is five (5) minutes after the class is called by the announcer.
- 10. Breakage of equipment in a class or line-up could result in disgualification. The extent of the break age will be at the discretion of the judge.
- 11. Classes with less than 3 entries will receive 2nd and 3rd place money. Some classes listed do not have a premium listed below their class name. If the class has a \$20.00 entry fee, the premiums follow \$45 \$35 \$30 \$25 \$15 Ribbon.



Racking vs Walking- A Horse may show in EITHER walking or racking classes at this show, but not both.

Racking Cross Entering-See KY-HIO rulebook for full Racking cross entering restrictions and rules.

Spotted Cross Entering-A Spotted Horse may cross enter into EITHER Walking or Racking Classes at this show, but not both. KY-HIO defers to SSHBEA rules as to Spotted Horse cross entering. See KY-HIO rulebook for more information.

Walking Cross Entering-Horses may not cross enter at this show between All Day Walking (3/8 x ¾ shoe), Trail Walking (3/8 x ¾ shoe), and Country Walking (3/8 x 1 shoe).

Registration Requirements-Spotted Horses do not have to be registered spotted. Racking horses do not have to be registered Racking. Country Pleasure Walking and All Day Pleasure Walking horses do not have to registered Walking. All other horses showing in specific Walking classes must be registered with TWHBEA.

Go As You Please Classes-Open to any nonpadded horse regardless of what other division it may have shown in. Walk/favorite gait. Judged on best overall presentation, rider-to-mount suitability, and correctness while in the ring. Spooking, failure to follow the rail, and other mistakes should be penalized since this is a mixed breed class. Front end action, or other specific qualities associated with a particular discipline should be neither rewarded nor penalized in this class.

Easy Gait Classes- Entries in these entry level classes do not have to be registered, but must be gaited horses wearing a 3/8 x 3/4 or smaller shoe. These horses should be ridden on a loose rein and should appear to be a pleasure to ride. The gaits are to be a true

walk, and a smooth, easy pleasure gait. Judged on rider to mount suitability, ability of horse to work comfortably on a loose rein, neatness of appearance and overall presentation, and behavior of the horse in the ring. Mistakes should be penalized in judging and horses in this class should never display a labored, crampy, or gimmicky gait. A smooth, comfortable, easy gait shall be the paramount requirement for horses tied favorably.

These rules supersede the rules of any HIO or other association rules at this show.

Notably, under the KY-HIO, vouth exhibitors may show a stallion in any class that is not a vouth class. *In addition, under the KY-HIO, a youth exhibitor may* show a pony stallion in a youth class that allows Ponies.

EASY GAIT

Entries in these classes do not need to be registered, but must be gaited horses wearing a 3/8 x 3/4 or smaller shoe. These horses should be ridden on a loose rein and should appear to be a pleasure to ride. The gaits are to be a true walk, and a smooth, easy pleasure gait. Judged on rider to mount suitability, ability of horse to work comfortably on a loose rein, neatness of appearance and overall presentation, and behavior of the horse in the ring. Mistakes should be penalized in judging and horses in this class should never display a labored, crampy, or gimmicky gait. A smooth, comfortable, easy gait shall be the paramount requirement for horses tied favorably.

Draft Horse Pull Information from the Horse Show Office

Teams that are entered in the Draft Horse Competition may also be entered in the Pulling Contest. All horses must be checked-in by the Superintendent by 8:00 a.m. on Friday, August 18, 2023.

- 1. ENTRY FEE--\$20.00 per team (Non-Refundable)
- ENTRY FORM—An entry form is to be completed and signed by the exhibitor. An office fee of \$5.00 per team will be applied. Entry deadline is July 5, 2023. If deadline is not met, a late fee of \$10.00 will be charged.
- 3. ADMISSION POLICY--Each pulling team entry will receive four (4) single day gate passes prior to the fair.
- HEALTH REGULATIONS--Coggins (for in-state horses) and Coggins and Health Certificate (for out of state horses). Please bring a paper copy with you for the office files.
- STALLS--\$20.00 per horse if stalls are available (does not include shavings). If stalls are not available, teams will be allowed on the fair grounds Friday morning, August 18, in time for the contest.
- 6. **DRAFT PULLING TEAM**--Draft team pair must be present at weigh-in.
- 7. **WEIGH IN**--Official Weigh-In will be 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. on the morning of the pull.
- WEIGHT CLASSES--Teams will be placed in Light Weight (3,400 pounds & Under) and Heavy Weight (3,401 pounds & Over) classes.
- 9. **ORDER OF PULL**--Pulling order will be announced just prior to the contest.
- 10. **QUALIFYING PULL--**Teams must make a qualifying pull to be eligible for prize money.
- 11. MANDATORY MEETING--Handler MUST attend mandatory meeting in front of Grandstand Stage at 8:30 a.m. on the morning of the pull.
- 12. **PREMIUMS**--Monetary awards will be mailed to the owner (specified on the entry form) within forty-five (45) days after the close of the State Fair of WV.

Draft Horse Pulling Rules

- 1. Pulling Distance-27 1/2 feet
- 2. Width of Pulling Area—20 feet
- Two Classes of Horses
 Light Weight— 3,400 pounds & under Heavy Weight—3,401 pounds & over
- 4. **Sled**—A stone boat or solid bottomed sled will be used for pulling. The first weight to be pulled will be a minimum of 3,000 pounds (including the sled). The judge will have the discretion to start at a higher weight.
- 5. Hookers—Two (2) hookers, plus a driver to drive the teams will be allowed. All helpers must stay behind eveners and remain silent once the team is hooked. The driver must drive the team from behind the eveners. Only the driver may call on the team.
- 6. **Boundaries**—If a team steps on or over the side line, the pull attempt will not be counted.
- 7. Three Pulls—Each driver is entitled to take 3 pulls. All teams must take the 1st pull. If he unhooks after the 1st pull, he forfeits his 2nd. He may come back, in order, for his 3rd attempt.
- 8. Time Limit—Each team will have 3 minutes to hook after being called for the first pull. 1 minute between the 1st and 2nd attempt. The time for the 3rd pull is the same as the 1st.
- 9. **Pull Attempts**—3 unsuccessful attempts to hook will count as 1 pull attempt. Driver will have 6 attempts to get hitched. If all 6 Attempts are missed the team will be eliminated. All the teams must take the 1st and 2nd pull to be entitled to a 3rd.
- 10. **Direction of Pull**—1st and 2nd pulls shall be taken in the direction indicated by the judge. The 3rd pull may be taken in either direction, providing the sled is not past the end marker.

- 11. **Movement of Sled**—Any forward movement of the sled after the driver gives command to go will be counted as a pull and measurement will be recorded, except with breakage of equipment. If sled is advanced over 18 inches between 2nd and 3rd attempts, the distance will be counted at 18 inches for 3rd attempt.
- 12. **Breakage of Equipment**—The team must remain in the pulling area and come in at the end of the round for their turn and pick up their proper place the next round. The team has 5 minutes to make repairs.
- 13. **Drivers**—Each team shall be driven by one driver at all times through the entire contest, except in the case of driver injury.
- 14. **Heading of Horses**—The heading of horses is prohibited. In case of unhooked tug, or horse over tug, the driver must unhitch from the sled, then correct the problem and then hitch again for the same pull.
- 15. **Treatment of Horses** Drivers shall not prod, whip or touch the horses while pulling and in no case whirl or shake the lines over horses or above his own head. Jumping of doubletree is not allowed. First penalty—loss of one pull attempt; Second penalty—disqualification from the entire pull.
- 16. Unmanageable Teams—If any team becomes unmanageable or difficult to handle, and in the opinion of the judges may endanger other teams, drivers, or spectators, they will be frozen in position and ordered taken from the field. If any team breaks away from the driver or helpers or runs away, it forfeits any premium it might have earned in the contest up to the time it runs away.
- 17. **Conduct of Horsemen**—Behavior of all horsemen (driver and helpers) will be above reproach at all times. Disciplinary action by the judges will be taken. Anyone disrupting the decision of the judges will be immediately disqualified. This includes all teams the driver has in the contest.

- 18. Bridles and Other Equipment—Bridles may be open-faced or with blinders. No change can be made after the contest starts. Teams may be tied together with check lines only. Hitching with cross tugs in prohibited. No bits, chains, or extras will be hung on the harness.
- 19. **Conduct of the Crowd**--Special effort will be made to keep the crowd quiet during each pull. If another teamster or handler interferes with the team making a pull, the person who interfered will be removed and his team disqualified.
- Exit the Fairgrounds--All teams will be expected to leave the grounds immediately following the contest and award presentations unless prior arrangements with management have been made.


