State Fair of WV Camping Rules & Regulations

- **Check in/Check out:** During fair week, check-in for sites with hookups begins at 12:00 PM and check-out is at 10:00 AM. Failure to check out on time may result in unit being towed at owner's expense.
- **Only One Unit per Site:** Only one RV/travel trailer and one vehicle is allowed on a campsite with hookups. All other vehicles must park in the free parking area. No tents allowed. Permits must be displayed at all times during stay.
- **Right to Refuse Access:** RV/travel trailer must be in good working order and appearance and carry current liability insurance. Management reserves the right to refuse access to any vehicle deemed unacceptable.
- **Vehicles:** No bikes, scooters or ATVs are permitted. Golf carts are allowed only with proof of liability insurance.
- **Speed Limit:** The campground speed limit is 5 MPH. Please drive slowly and watch for pedestrians.
- **Dump Stations:** Disposal of liquid waste (including sewage and gray water) is strictly prohibited. Please use dump station located at Bath House #1.
- **Fires:** No open fires allowed. Grills are permitted but must be attended at all times while in use.
- **Drug Policy:** Possession/use of drugs is strictly prohibited.
- **Firearms and Weapons:** Firearms, weapons, and explosives are not permitted.
- **Fireworks/Hazardous Materials:** Fireworks/hazardous materials are prohibited. Anyone violating this policy will be asked to leave immediately without refund.
- **Pet Policy:** Guests must clean up after pets. Pets must remain on a leash and under control at all times. Pets are not permitted on fairgrounds or in bathhouses. Owner must have proof of vaccination within the last 12 months. Impersonating a service dog is a crime punishable by fines or jail time.
- **Commercial Activity:** Soliciting or conducting business on the property is prohibited.
- **Prohibited Conduct:** Harassment, discrimination, or offensive behavior towards staff or other guests will result in immediate eviction without a refund. Campers are responsible for actions of all members of their party and any visitors. Camper agrees to pay for any damage caused while on the premises.
- **Quiet Hours:** Quiet hours are 11PM-6AM. All generators must be turned off during this time.
- **Noise Control:** Loud music or excessive noise that disturbs other guests is prohibited at all times.
- **No Littering:** Please keep the campground clean. DO NOT move the trash cans provided by management.
- **Guest Responsibility:** Campers are responsible for the actions of, and any damage/injury caused by, all members of their party, visitors and pets. Camper agrees to pay for damage caused while on the premises.
- **Indemnification Clause:** Guests agree to indemnify and hold harmless the SFVV, its officers, directors, and employees from and against any and all claims, demands, causes of action, liability, losses, damages, penalties, and expenses, including court costs and attorney's fees, arising from or incurred because of The Campers' actual or alleged actions or omissions with respect to the premises. The Camper assumes all risk of liability arising from or in connection with his rental of the camping space and other activities at the premises and assumes and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to, or theft or destruction of, his equipment and personal property at the premises.
- **Compliance with Laws:** All guests must comply with campground rules as well as all federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Violators will be asked to leave the property.
- **Right to Refuse Service:** The property is privately owned. Management reserves the right to refuse service to anyone at any time for any reason deemed necessary.
- **Policy Changes:** Management reserves the right to modify and add rules and policies as needed.
- **Refunds:** Cancellations in writing will receive a refund, minus a 10% processing fee. **NO REFUNDS** after July 31st.
